- To help and assist financially or otherwise the needy families by providing accommodation, shelter, clothes, and equipment's, utensils and furniture etc.
- To help and assist financially or otherwise needy members by providing medicines, medical treatment, hospitalizations, health facilities, etc.
- To help and assist financially or otherwise needy members at time of marriage, social and religious events.
- To help and assist by cash and or kind the sufferers at time of calamity, flood or other natural disasters.
- To acquire places and plots of land for graveyard and promote facilities of burial
- To help and assist financially or otherwise needy families and their members.
- To financially assist needy families by providing with Qarze Hasna



- To acquire land and buildings and/or construct, renovate or repair hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, schools, colleges, madarsas, hostels, libraries, training institutes, ambulances etc.
- To run, operate and manage such hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, schools, , colleges, madarsas, hostels libraries, training institutes, ambulances which are repaired or renovated by Syed Foundation.
- To help poor, needy and deserving people by providing food, medicines, clothes, temporary shelter or in any other manner, particularly in times of emergencies, disasters, floods and other natural calamities.
- To accepts donations, gifts, subscriptions and deal with it in same way as the purpose of organization.
- To do all such other things and acts which are desired for any welfare service and or necessary or incidental for carrying out above objects.

4. ACTIVITIES DONE BY SYED FOUNDATION:

The canvas of activities of Syed Foundation has been diversified and multifaceted. From arranging lunches and dinners, mango parties, food drive, distribution of ration bags, medicines, providing educational support, and measure to protect against covid. Syed Foundation has been accomplishing these tasks with high degree of integration and dedication.

The dynamic nature of the range of social services done by Syed Foundation is as follows:



4.1 WEEKLY LUNCH/DINNER ARRANGED AT CENTRE FOR OLDER PEOPLE, DARUL-SUKUN AND IDARIEU SCHOOL FOR BLIND AND DEAF:

Syed Foundation arrange weekly Sunday lunch at center for elder people Dar-ul-Sukun and Ida Rieu School for Blind and Deaf. Further one Saturday of every month, lunch is arranged at Abbasi Shaheed Hospital. Sometimes additional things, such as Kashmiri Tea, is added as a part of lunch/dinner.

























4.2 FOOD DRIVES:

Unfortunately many people, here in Pakistan, are deprived of basic necessity such as food. Frequently, Syed Foundation organize lunch/dinner at various places such as Mehran Town, AramBagh, Malir, Malir Cantt, Gulistan-e-Johar and Lyari etc. It has also distributed food in organizations such as "Anjuman Kashan-e-Atfal". Apart from this, food drive is now expanded in other cities such as Hyderabad and Jacobabad.

4.3 EGG DISTRIBUTION:

Eggs are an important source of proteins and other important nutrients. Keeping this in mind and the rising inflation, Syed Foundation donates 300 eggs every month to Dar-ul-Sukun and among other needy people



4.4 MEDICAL FACILITIES:

One of the primary objective of Syed Foundation was to provide medical aid in terms of distributing medicines and giving financial aid in order to clear hospital bills and meet other medical needs.

So far, we have achieved our objective by donating wheel chairs, walkers and fully equipped hospital bed to Alamgir Welfare Trust Hospital.

Apart from this medicines worth of Rs. 120,000/- have been distributed. Moreover, Rs. 55,000/- was paid to clear hospital bills and along with donation of Rs. 10,000/- for other medical related facilities. 89 medicine boxes were also donated at SIUT during Covid Pandemic.

In order to help hospitals like Abbasi Shaheed and SIUT, who are serving millions of people every day, Syed Foundation donated bed sheets and towels.

4.5 FINANCIAL AID:

In accordance with our objective of helping people in every possible way, Rs. 88,000/- has been paid to assist various families to fulfill their needs, such as buying groceries, paying utility bills etc.



4.6 EDUCATIONAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIP:

In order to promote education and appreciate the students getting good results. Tuition fees of Rs. 100,000/- is being paid to different students at school, college and university level so they can continue their education. The students we currently support on monthly basis are from Habib Public School, Quill Grammer School, Iqra Taj School, Magnanious Schooling, Fahim School



System, St. Paul's School, Trinity Methodist School, S.M Public School and NED University of Engineering and Technology. Moreover, admission fees is also paid of student of IBA and Dow University, so they can start their professional education career. Further, 26 school bags with accessories (lunch box, bottle and pencil boxes) were also distributed.

Educational Scholarships given on need basis worth Rs. 30,000/- to various students.

4.7 RENOVATION OF SCHOOL:

In order to promote education, Syed Foundation has collaborated with Hamdast Foundation to renovate an underpriviledge primary school in Gulistan-e-Johar for boys and girls. The work of school is under progress.





4.8 DISTRIBUTION OF FLOUR BAGS:

125 Flour Bags of 10 kg each are distributed monthly among people, to help them make both ends meet. This makes around 1500 bags per year.

4.9 DISTRIBUTION OF GROCERY BAGS:

35 grocery bags monthly is given to families worth Rs, 4000/- each in Karachi and 400 grocery bags were distributed in Jacobabad of Rs. 1,400,000/-. Furthermore, grocery bags were also distributed in Islahuddin Hockey Academy for players and support staff.

KARACHI,: The Karachi Sports Forum and Syed Foundation with the cooperation of Federal Minister for Privatization Muhammad Mian Soomro distributed ration bags among the players and sportspersons of Jacobabad, Larkana and Sukkur who are facing financial hardships due to the lockdown imposed there to contain the advancement of Covid-19.

As many as 200 ration bags have been distributed under the second phase of ration distribution campaign of KSF and Syed Foundation while in the first phase around 200 bags were distributed in Jacobabad.

The ration bags were handed over to the officials of various sports associations for distribution among the families of deserving athletes. In this connection an event was organized at the residence of Minister Muhammad Mian Soomro which was attended by representatives of associations of softball, karate, taekwondo, boxing, hockey, gymnastics, wanjh vati and others sports.

Manager of Soomro House Rashid Ahmed Kalhoro, Syed Foundation representative Faraz Aijaz, KSF's Khaldoon Raja, Abdul Subhan and Zulfiqar Ahmed were also present on the occasion.

Meanwhile, Syed Waseem Hashmi, President of Syed Foundation said that over 1500 families have so far received ration bags in four phases of the KSF campaign.—Agencies



4.10 STEPS TO PREVENT COVID'19:

In order to control the spread of Covid'19, 2100 sanitizer pouches and 1200 face masks were distributed. Vaccination drives and free covid test campaign was also conducted to facilitate the players, supporting staff and their families.

Moreover 25 Oxygen cylinders worth Rs. 275,000/- were given to SIUT and 50 oxygen cylinders worth Rs. 550,000/- were given to Alamgir Welfare Trust along with 10 oximeters. An oxygen cylinder bank was also formed with Alamgir Welfare Trust to facilitated people associated with Syed Foundation.

4.11 WINTER DRIVE:

Due to extreme winters, 1200 blankets worth Rs. 780,000/- were distributed in Indus Hospital, Abbasi Shaheed Hospital, people residing in Lyari, Orangi and Korangi. Moreover, it was distributed to the security staff of Hamdard University, Newport Institute of Communication & Economics (NICE) and ground staff of National Stadium.

Moreover 110 woolen chadars and 50 woolen jackets were also distributed. The winter drive was successfully done in Karachi, Quetta, Rawalpindi and Lahore

4.12 RAMZAAN PROJECT

On the auspicious occasion of Ramzaan, Syed Foundation worked selflessly for betterment of people. It actively participated in all the tasks, with the help of donations of their valuable contributors.

The work done in Ramzaan is mentioned below:



- Arranged 24 dinners at different locations such as Darul-Sukun along with iftar every day at Shafi Masjid, Gulaothi, India.
- 1000kg Atta was distributed
- 75 litter of Ghee/Oil was distributed.
- 32 Sewing Machines were donated
- Chocolates, biscuits and Chips were distributed in Dar ul Sukun for special children
- Rs. 15,000 were donated to special children at Dar Ul Sukun
- 280 Ration Bags were distributed
- Flour and Wheat (200kg) were distribututed
- 400kg Rice & 300kg Atta was donated to Dar UI Sukun Kashmir Road, Darul Sukoon MA Jinnh Road, Blind School Nazimabad Karachi and IdaRieu deaf and Blind School.
- Medicines worth of Rs 5,000/- were donated.
- To promote education, Rs/- 10,000 was paid as fee for IBA for a deserving Student and school Fee worth of Rs 4000 was paid for needy students in Lahore.
- 400 Hand Sanitizers and 100 face masks were distributed as prevention against covid.
- 6,000 packets of dates were distributed on daily basis














4.16 CONTRIBUTIONS TO OTHER SECTORS:

- Distribution of biscuits and juices among blind and deaf children on occasion of White Can Day




