Syed Foundation a non-profit and non-governmental organization is a beacon of hope and catalyst for change. Committed to its core values of compassion, empowerment, and community, it has tirelessly worked towards fostering positive transformations in the lives of underprivileged people. Some of the challenges faced by poverty-stricken families include unavailability of food and clean water, access to improper education system and health facilities, poor infra-structure, increase in unemployment ratio and the list goes on. It is working selflessly for the welfare of people irrespective of their caste, color, creed or religion.

Syed Foundation is registered trust which has approval of a Non-Profit Organization with Income Tax Authorities u/s 2(36) of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001. It also registered in FBR as a non-profit organization and the license is renewed every year. It is working on Donations, Sadqat, Zakat and Lillah. Since its formation, in 2017, it has tried to improve the conditions of people by participating in different socio-economic activities and create a positive impact on communities.

## **ACHIEVEMENTS OF SYED FOUNDATION:**

Syed Foundation has navigated challenges and seized opportunities, guided by the collective dedication to its mission. The notable achievements and milestones that have defined our progress over the past six months are:

### **1. MOU Signing with Research & Development Foundation (RDF):**

Research and Development Foundation (RDF) is a PCP certified not for profit organization, working in rural and semi urban areas of Sindh province of Pakistan. It is an action research and community development organization, of that the main purpose is to bring equitable development to marginalized and poor groups. It is registered under Societies Act 1860, in the year 2002.

Syed Foundation successfully forged a meaningful partnership through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Research and Development Foundation. This collaborative effort aimed to address development in rural areas, work on rights of women, encourage sports facilities in Sindh, lay down foundation of a training institute of stitching and collaborate in future welfare projects.

President of Syed Foundation, Mr. Wasim Uddin Hashmi and Executive Director of Research and Development Foundation, Mr. Ashfaque Ahmed Soomro briefed about the work done by both the organizations. The objectives outlined in the MOU were diligently pursued, with milestones achieved in areas such as during devastating flood 2022 and Ramadan 2023. The collaborative efforts not only strengthened the impact of individual organizations but also contributed significantly to the broader community. This partnership reflects commitment to fostering collective impact and leveraging shared resources for the greater good.





## 2. MOU Signing with Alamgir Welfare Trust International:

Alamgir Welfare Trust International is a social welfare organization and charity in Karachi, Pakistan which provides services in a wide variety of domains including health, education and feeding the underprivileged, etc. It was established in 1993 and is headquartered at Bahadurabad, Karachi.

Syed Foundation has been collaborating with Alamgir Welfare Trust International for the past ten years to serve the poor and needy. Some of the work done together includes:

- Provision of coolers for clean water.
- Distribution of cooked meals for the impoverished.
- Assistance with burials.
- Support for coolies at railway station who suffered during flood 2022.
- Dowry provisions.
- Educational opportunities for deserving students.

In recognition of the impactful work carried out by Syed foundation, Alamgir Welfare Trust International has officially signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), to establish partnership, collaborate on shared goals and support each other to solve the social and economic issues faced by the people.

The MoU was signed by Chaudhary Nisar Ahmed, Chairman Alamgir Welfare Trust International and Mr. Wasim Hashmi, President Syed Foundation, at a ceremony held in auditorium of Alamgir Welfare Trust International. Eminent speakers addressed the audience.

With SF and AWIT working hand in hand, utilizing all their abilities under guiding personalities and leadership will string them together into a beautiful necklace of service.

## ACTIVITIES DONE BY SYED FOUNDATION:

The canvas of activities of Syed Foundation has been diversified and multifaceted. Arranging lunches, distribution of grocery and flour bags, providing medicines and other health related facilities, educational support and scholarships, service of qurbani and sadqa etc... Syed Foundation has been accomplishing these tasks with high degree of integration and dedication.

The dynamic nature of the range of social services done by Syed Foundation is as follows:

### 1. Education Scholarships:

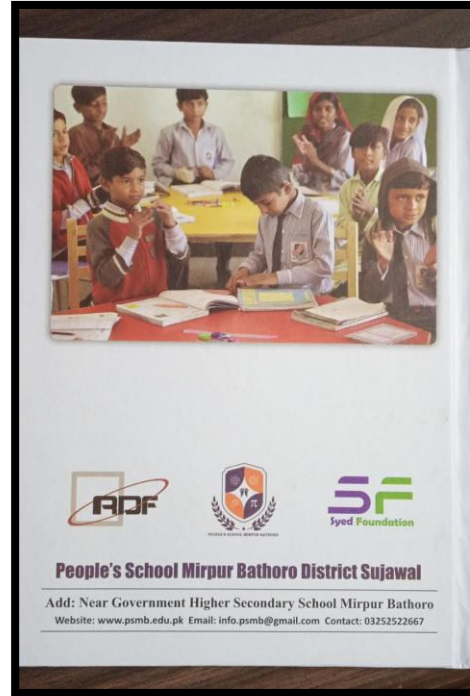
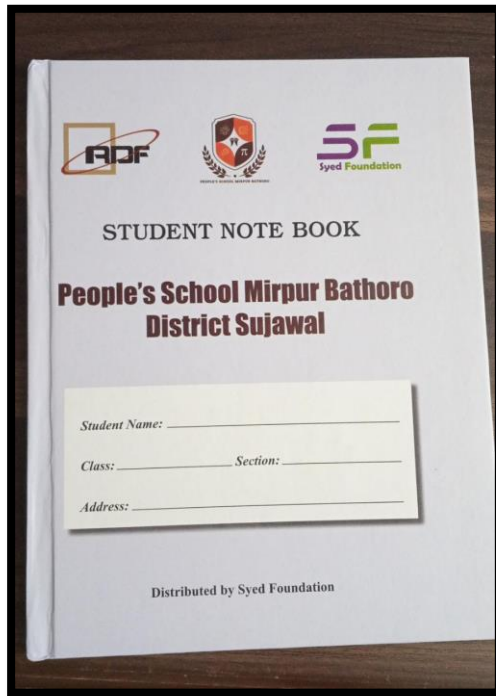

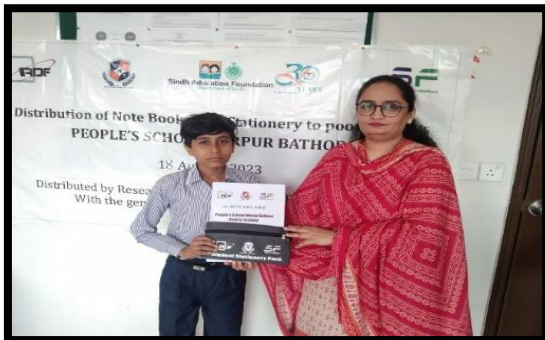
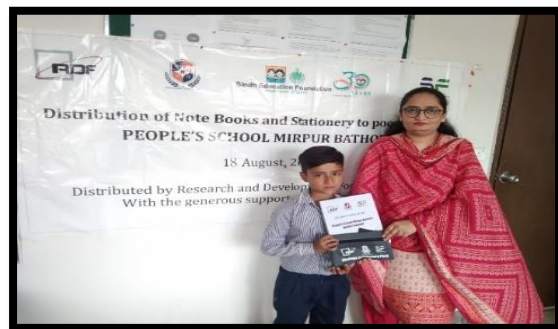
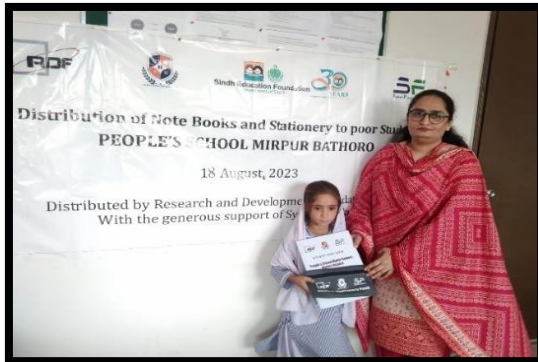
Syed Foundation mission is to transform the lives of children and their families living in poverty by providing access to quality education. In the past six months the various donations made for this purpose are as follows:

- In the past six months, Syed foundation has provided admission and semester fees totaling to around Rs. 641,000/- to deserving university students, empowering them to pursue education and chart a course towards a bright future.



- During the past six months, Syed Foundation has extended school scholarships to 66 students across various schools including Habib Public School, Magnanimous Schooling, Iqra Taj School, Quill Grammar School, Zion School, M.D Public School, Little flower Academy, Educators School, SMIU, The Heaven City School and Al-Khair Academy, offering a cumulative financial support of Rs. 498,000/- This initiative underscores our commitment to fostering education accessibility and empowering students from diverse educational background.
- Stationary packs and registers, having worth of Rs. 250,000/- were distributed among students of SMIU School Karachi and Peoples School MirpurKhas and Sujawal.





- Three cupboards were given for the classes of special children in the Rehabilitation Centre of Darul Sukun.



## 2. Medical Assistance:

*“We know only too well that what we are doing is nothing more than a drop in the ocean. But if the drop were not there, the ocean would be missing something.”-Mother Teresa*

One of the primary objectives of Syed Foundation is to provide aid in terms of distribution of medicines, clearing hospital bills, help in operations etc. The details of donations made for this purpose are as follows:

- SF provides a financial aid of Rs. 150,000/- in the past six months to Omair Sana Welfare Foundation, a well-known organization treating Thalassemia patients.
- For the treatment of an especially able girl at Islamic Medical Center, Rawalpindi, Syed Foundation has provided a financial aid of Rs. 150,000/- during the past six months.
- Contributed in providing a hospital bed to a bed-ridden patient.
- SF has extended vital financial support, allocating a total amount of Rs. 354,800/-to aid various patients in covering expenses for essential medicines and crucial lab tests.
- Financial support of Rs. 50,000/- was given to a patient for his essential surgery at Bantva Anis Hospital.



## 3. Food Drives:

*“There is nothing greater than love invested in helping to feed the impoverished living in hunger.”

As food is the basic necessity of every human being, Syed foundation has always tried to feed the underprivileged people. For this purpose, the following activities were conducted:

- During the past six months, Syed Foundation conducted food drives every week on Sunday at institutions where people are residing such as Darul Sukun center for old people, Idarieu School for Blind and Deaf and Aashiyana House, worth of Rs. 698,000/- feeding around 1500 people.
- Once each month lunchboxes were distributed in Gulistan-e-Johar in collaboration with Ehsas-e-Bashr, of worth Rs. 18,000/- feeding 300 people.

- Provided 50 packets of biryani of worth Rs. 11,000/- at an event on 24th November at Liyari, Karachi.



#### **4. Financial Assistance:**

*"No one has ever become poor from giving." – Anne Frank.*

Syed foundation has contributed for financial assistance, directly addressing the urgent needs of individuals. This financial support has been instrumental in providing relief and support to those facing economic hardships. The detailed information on this contribution is as follows:

- Syed Foundation has provided consistent financial assistance to 9 families each month over the past six months, with a total cumulative worth of Rs. 438,000/-.
- In our project of Marriage Assistance, Rs. 107,000/- donation was given to needy families.
- Contributed Rs. 39,750/- for construction of roof of house for poverty-stricken families.

#### **5. Distribution of Grocery and Flour Bags:**

*"Feeding the hungry is not just a charitable act; it is a profound expression of our shared humanity and a commitment to building a world where no one goes to bed hungry."-Unknown*

Syed Foundation contribution to the provision of essential grocery bags for vulnerable communities is as follows:

- Ration bags worth Rs. 1,920,000/- were distributed among 50 families every month, courtesy by Orchard Grammar School.
- Monthly Chase grocery vouchers were distributed among 42 families, having the total worth of Rs. 252,000/- .Moreover Syed foundation contributed Rs. 5,000/- in Inflation Relief Program with Khas Foundation to distribute flour.
- Contributed Rs. 18,000/- over the period of past six months in order to provide boxes of Porridge and Cerelac for children and senior citizens residing at Darul Sukun.



## 6. Hand Pumps:

*Allah says in Quran “Indeed, the men who practice charity and the women who practice charity and [they who] have loaned Allah a goodly loan – it will be multiplied for them, and they will have a noble reward.”- [57:18]*

In impoverished regions, communities often lack access to reliable water sources, leading to waterborne diseases and other health-related issues. The installation of hand pumps seeks to mitigate these challenges by providing a sustainable and accessible water supply.

The hand pump installation project focuses on identifying and addressing specific areas with high water scarcity and limited access to clean water. Target locations are chosen based on a thorough needs assessment, considering factors such as population density, existing water infrastructure, and health indicators.

70 hand pumps worth of Rs. 1,750,000/- were installed, in collaboration with Alamgir Welfare Trust International, to help in supply of water among poor families residing in Mityari, Larkana and Khairpur.

In conclusion, the hand pump installation project represents a crucial step towards addressing water challenges in impoverished areas. By combining technological solutions with community engagement, this initiative contributes to sustainable development and improved quality of life for vulnerable populations.









## **7. Winter Drive:**

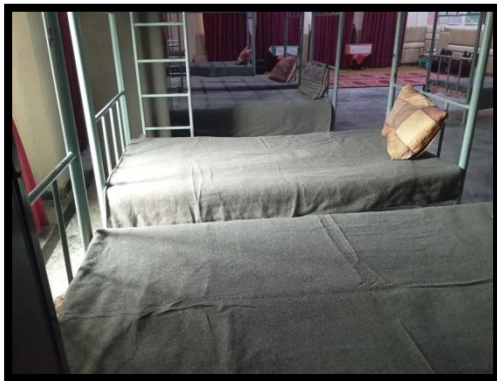
This winter, Syed Foundation successfully contributed to providing warmth and comfort to those in need by distributing blankets, jackets, shoes and socks worth of Rs. 1,423,250/-. The distribution details are as follows:

- Blankets were distributed among underprivileged families in Tando Allahyar-Sindh, Tando Adam-Sindh, Village of Goundariro District Khairpur-Sindh, Larkana-Sindh, Sukkur-Sindh, Hyderabad-Sindh, Peshawar-KPK, Quetta-Baluchistan, Kalam-KPK, Abbottabad-KPK and Nathiagali-KPK.
- Received in-kind donation of 210 blankets, from Mr. Khaldoon Raja. These were donated among the needy families of interior Sindh.
- Blankets and Jackets were sent to NGO Aabroo Educational Welfare Organization in Lahore, and were distributed among underprivileged families in Punjab.
- Mr. David Vincent, representative of Christian community living in Rawalpindi, received and distributed the warm blankets among the needy Christian families. Moreover, blankets were distributed among the needy Christian families in Karachi.
- In the spirit of caring for our community blankets were distributed among the hardworking security guards of different Universities, Sports venues, certain Government offices and clubs in Karachi.
- The house helps workers, drivers and homeless people living on roadsides living in Karachi, have received blankets, providing them with warmth and comfort.
- Furthermore, welfare institutes in Karachi, like Darul Sukun Kashmir Road, Darul Sukun Old House, Idarieu School for blind and deaf, Aashiyana Trust and Abbasi Shaheed Hospital, received and distributed the warm blankets.
- Blanket distributions have reached visually impaired families of Karachi, providing them with warmth and comfort in the face of colder conditions.
- In the heart of Karachi, blankets have gently settled in the hands of those in need across diverse Karachi neighborhoods, North Nazimabad, North Karachi, New Karachi, different sectors of Orangi Town, Malir Cantt, Mehmoodabad, Cantt station area, Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Gulistan-e-Jauhar, DHA, Ahsanabad, Baloch Colony and Gulshan-e-Maymaar.
- Poor students of People’s School Mirpur Batholo District Sujawal received jackets.
- Furthermore, jackets were distributed among children in Peshawar-KPK, Larkana-Sindh, Kalam-KPK and Nathiagali-KPK.
- Distributed shoes and socks among children in Peshawar-KPK, Lahore-Punjab, Kalam-KPK and Abbottabad-KPK.









## 8. Sadqah-e-Jariah:

- Contributed Rs. 40,000/- in construction of a Masjid-e-Ibrahim at Scheme 33, Karachi, courtesy by Dr. Zubaida Shahwar.
- Contributed Rs. 80,000/- in construction of a Masjid-e-Ibrahim at Scheme 33, Karachi by Alamgir Welfare Trust International, for Sawab-e-Jaria of (Late) Syed Hamid Ali Jafri and (Late) Syeda Razia Rifat Jafri.

## 9. Training Institute for Stitching:

The stitching center has been established in Tando Allah Yar, Sindh, in collaboration with Research & Development Foundation. The women are given training, after which they will be provided with an interest-free loan to start their business. The seed money for the loan scheme is 1.5 million rupees.







## 10. Sadqah:

*Prophet Muhammad (SallallahuAlaihiWasallam) Said: "Sadaqah wipes out sins like water extinguishes fire." – [Tirmidhi]*

Syed Foundation provides service of doing Sadqah in form of either slaughtering of animal or provision of grocery bags.

- Since July, **14** goats have been slaughtered, and the meat was distributed to poor people.
- To address the immediate needs of vulnerable families facing harsh conditions, two grocery bags worth of Rs. 18,000/- each and one grocery bag worth of Rs. 45,000/- were distributed among the needy families.

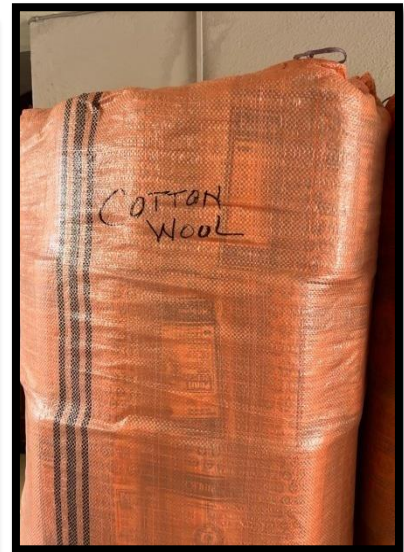
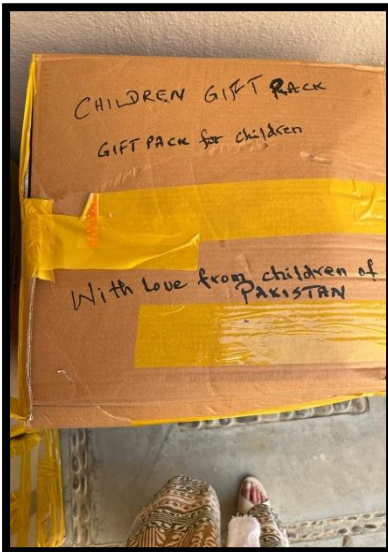
## 11. Humanitarian Aid for Gaza:

*You don't need to be Muslim to care and pray for Gaza. You just need to be Human.*

The Palestinian territories, particularly the West Bank and Gaza Strip, continue to face complex challenges, including political instability, economic hardship, and limited access to essential services. The aid provided is geared towards alleviating these challenges and fostering a path towards sustainable development.

In response to the urgent humanitarian situation in Gaza, Syed Foundation in collaboration with the 70-F Friends of Humanity Foundation, have been able to generate fund of Rs.7,850,000/- Alhamdulillah, 4 trucks were dispatched and delivered to Islamabad, containing blankets and medical supplies. The Palestinian Embassy requested NDMA of Pakistan to assist them in sending goods to Egypt via aircraft. The aircraft was arranged once the cargo collected was enough and hence our relief packages were sent to Gaza.





## 12. Independence Day and Tree Plantation Drive:

Tree plantation is crucial for numerous reasons. Firstly, trees play a pivotal role in combating climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide and releasing oxygen during photosynthesis, thereby mitigating the greenhouse effect. Additionally, they contribute to biodiversity by providing habitats for various species. Trees also help prevent soil erosion, conserve water, and improve air quality by filtering pollutants. Beyond environmental benefits, tree planting supports local economies and communities by offering sustainable resources like timber and fruits. Overall, tree plantation is a fundamental practice for fostering a healthier planet and ensuring a sustainable future.

Therefore, on the occasion of Pakistan's 76th Independence Day, Syed Foundation took the initiative of planting trees in collaboration with RDF in Tando Allah Yar and NJV School (adopted by Akhuwat Foundation) in Nathiagali, Karachi. This step not only helped to promote a greener and clean Pakistan but also helped combat climate change. 350 plants of diverse variety were planted, paving the way for sustainable environment.







### 13. White Cane Day:

White Cane Safety Day, observed on October 15<sup>th</sup>, aims to raise awareness about the importance of the white cane as a symbol of independence and mobility for people with visual impairments. This day highlights the significance of white canes in enhancing the safety and mobility of individuals who are blind or visually impaired. The white cane not only helps navigate physical obstacles but also signifies the user's right to move freely and independently in their surroundings. White Cane Safety Day promotes understanding and respect for those with visual impairments, fostering a more inclusive society that recognizes and supports the autonomy of individuals with blindness.

Syed Foundation in collaboration with Voice of Blind and Silver line school celebrated White cane day on 15<sup>th</sup> October at Mazar-e-Quaid, where juices and water bottles were distributed among blind children.



#### **14. Seminar of Breast Cancer Awareness:**

Breast Cancer Awareness Month, observed annually in October, serves as a global campaign dedicated to raising awareness about breast cancer, emphasizing the importance of early detection, treatment, and support for those affected. During this month, various organizations, communities, and individuals unite to promote education about breast health, encourage regular screenings, and honor the strength and resilience of breast cancer survivors. The iconic pink ribbon symbolizes solidarity and underscores the collective efforts to fight against this prevalent form of cancer, ultimately aiming to reduce its impact through widespread awareness and support.

Syed Foundation conducted three sessions to address the audience and give information about early diagnosis, treatment and prevention. The sessions were conducted at the following venues:

- FBR by Dr. Rufina Soomro, FCPS, FRCS, FACS, Professor, Department of General Surgery on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- Sindh Madrasa tul Islam University by Dr. Usra Pervaiz, Assistant Professor, Breast Surgical Oncologist, SIUT, on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2023.
- New Port Institute of Communications and Economics by Dr. Shabnam Shamim Asim, Professor and Consultant, Department of Gynecology & Obstetrics, Karachi Medical and Dental College and Abbasi Shaheed Hospital, on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

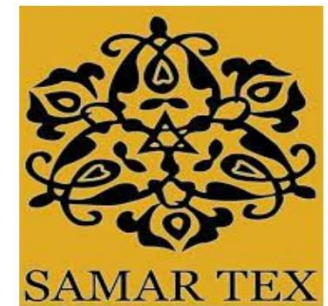
